



Dynamic Duos!

Essential Eligibility Criteria:

EECs should not be seen as blocks to participation, but rather as a tool to help ensure your camper has the fundamental skills required to be safe and successful in our *specific* camp.

IF camper does not meet EEC and has a caregiver that will provide services allowing camper to meet EEC, they may be considered for acceptance on a case by case basis. Contact program coordinator for details.

- Language must be comprehensible by others. Able to participate in group activities that require conversation skills, follow verbal directions, and participate in simple discussions. (We welcome personal AAC devices).
- Manages bladder and bowels with minimum assistance
- Minimal to moderate assistance using wheelchair, walker or other mobility aids
- If using wheelchair, moderate physical assistance from one individual to complete transfers
- Must be able to wear a PFD for participation in water activities
- No significant emotional or behavioral regulation challenges - The camper can participate in a 1:1 camper to volunteer ratio successfully
- Campers should have the skills to handle the sleep-away-from-home aspects of the camp program, including living independently in a group setting and taking care of their own personal needs with prompting when needed. (Independent completing ADL's including but not limited to toileting, hygiene, feeding, dressing and transfers).

What are considered significant emotional and behavioral regulation challenges and outside of the scope of application criteria?

- Significant emotional regulation challenges would include: consistently running away and/or hiding when upset, consistently unable to regulate emotions with support from adults, etc.
- Significant behavioral regulation challenges would include; frequent physical contact with others (hitting, biting, spitting, etc.), unable to leave a situation with support from an adult, etc.

EXCLUSIONARY CRITERIA:

- Verbal IQ 45 and below
- Physical aggression or self-injurious behavior
- Drug or alcohol use/abuse
- Conduct Disorder
- Sexually acting out/inappropriate sexual behaviors

The following conditions are ones that necessitate care which cannot be adequately handled by the camp health or counseling staff:

- Suctioning
- Colostomy
- Tracheotomy
- Urostomy
- Gastronomy tubes
- Apnea
- Injections
- Ongoing oxygen
- Diabetes/insulin support [refer to Camp BETA]
- Ventilator dependency
- Decubitus

There are many other health conditions which will necessitate individual evaluation. Please provide as much information as possible so that our medical screening committee can evaluate your camper.
